What is a sore throat?

- A sore throat is pain, scratchiness or irritation of the throat that often worsens when you swallow.
- A sore throat is the primary symptom of pharyngitis — inflammation of the throat (pharynx).

What are the symptoms of a sore throat?

Symptoms of a sore throat may vary depending on the cause. Signs and symptoms may include:

- Pain or a scratchy sensation in the throat
- Pain that worsens with swallowing or talking
- Difficulty swallowing
- Dry throat
- Sore, swollen glands in your neck or jaw
- Swollen, red tonsils
- White patches or pus on your tonsils
- Hoarse or muffled voice

What are the causes of a sore throat?

Most sore throats are caused by viruses that cause the common cold and flu (influenza). A sore throat caused by a virus resolves on its own with at-home care. Less often, sore throats are due to bacterial infections, such as strep throat (streptococcal infection), which requires additional treatment with antibiotic drugs to prevent complications.

Other less common causes of sore throat may require more complex treatment.

Sore throat prevention tips

The germs that cause viral and bacterial infections are contagious. Therefore, the best prevention is to practice good hygiene. Follow these tips and teach your child to do the same:

- Wash your hands thoroughly and frequently, especially after using the toilet, before eating, and after sneezing or coughing.
- Avoid sharing food, drinking glasses or utensils.
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue and throw it away. When necessary, sneeze into your elbow.
- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizers as an alternative to hand-washing when soap and water aren't available.
- Regularly clean telephones, TV remotes and computer keyboards with sanitizing cleanser. When you travel, clean phones and remotes in your hotel room.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Humidify your home if the air is dry.

- Sodium chloride known for its anti-inflammatory properties and antibacterial properties which help flush out bacteria.

Recommended Use: For soothing sore throat by moisturizing and providing a soothing protective film over the throat's mucous membrane.

Recommended Dose and Duration of Use: Adults and children 12 years and older: Direct the spray nozzle at the region of inflammation in the throat and apply orally one spray for 2-3 seconds 4-6 times a day. Children should be supervised when using this product. Consult a healthcare practitioner for use beyond 1 month.

Precautions: For single user only. To be directed at throat region only. If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, consult a healthcare practitioner prior to use. If you have diabetes, consult a healthcare practitioner prior to use. Should you experience discomfort, or if symptoms persist or worsen, consult a healthcare practitioner.

Contraindication: Do not use if you are allergic to plants of the Asteraceae Compositae/Daisy family. Hypersensitivity (e.g., allergy) has been known to occur; in which case, discontinue use.


Storage Conditions: Store between 15 and 30°C.

Bag-on-Valve Technology:



Salinex® Throat Spray uses Bag-on-Valve technology: product is filled in a bag contained within the can. The propellant gas is filled into the area between the aluminum can and the bag containing the product. Product is therefore separated from the propellant gas so that when the container is dispensed, only the product is expelled, while the gas remains in the package and is never mixed with the product.



CAUTION: CONTAINER MAY EXPLODE IF HEATED
